Financial Projections

Counsilman Hunsaker, a nationally-renowned aquatic planning and design firm, determined that a self-sustaining aquatics facility is feasible in Winchester. Their 2014 study found that the facility should include a competition pool, recreation pool, and fitness spaces to successfully cover costs. In 2021, the Isaac Sports Group confirmed and updated the initial feasibility study. Their analysis provided an in-depth programming model and detailed financial projections based on the facility's preliminary design.

The Isaac Sports Group financial analysis assumes membership fees that are in line with rates for local community pool facilities. There will also be daily-use options for non-members. The program analysis plans for a wide range of aquatic and fitness activities in the facility. The facility is expected to break even by its third year of operations. The business plan includes a yearly contribution to a capital reserve fund for long term replacement and maintenance expenditures.
